#### **MBTA Directions & Parking Instructions**

The Legal Services Center is located directly next to the **Stony Brook MBTA** station on the T's **Orange Line**. Make a left as soon as you exit the T station, and walk toward the back of the station. We're the building that is set back from the street.

Depending on the direction you are driving on Amory Street, take a right or *left on Marbury Terrace*. Follow it to the end and turn left into the parking lot; you'll see an ice rink on the right. Take the walkway from the parking lot that runs between our building and the Stony Brook T substation, and follow it to the front entrance.
